**A MARQUEE FOR THE TREE  
Palace Theater Designs Limited Edition Christmas Ornament**

WATERBURY – It's beginning to look a lot like Christmas at the Palace Theater. As the venue begins decking its halls in anticipation of its holiday presentations of *Irving Berlin's White Christmas* (Nov. 6-8), *Cirque Dreams Holiday* (Nov. 29 & 30) and *'Twas A Girls Night Before Christmas The Musical* (Dec. 10), the theater is also offering patrons a chance to trim their own trees with a limited edition Palace ornament.

Manufactured by Woodbury Pewter, the intricately crafted ornament depicts an engraved image of the Palace's landmark marquee, which was designed from a photograph taken by Palace Theater Historian and Photographer Louis Belloisy.

Each ornament retails for \$15 and can be purchased at the Box Office, 100 E. Main St. in Waterbury, during regular business hours and all upcoming November and December events, beginning Nov. 6. Proceeds from sales benefit the Palace Theater Annual Campaign.
