## FUN FACTS!

- Blue Man Group was founded in New York City in 1987, by Chris Wink, Matt Goldman, and Phil Stanton, beginning as street performance art before developing into a stage show.
- In 1991, Blue Man Group opened its first full performance at the Astor Place Theater. This run concluded in 2025, after more than 17,000 performances.
- Blue Men never speak, either on stage or during “disturbances” (non-stage public appearances).
- Blue Man Group has performed in 15 different countries, over 100 US cities and has been seen by more than 50 million people worldwide.
- Their resident show in Las Vegas at Luxor Hotel & Casino recently celebrated its 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.
- It takes a performer about an hour to get ready in the signature blue makeup before each performance.
- The Blue Men use up to 8 boxes of Cap’n Crunch cereal, 385 marshmallows, 50 gallons of paint, and 40 drumsticks a week!
- **Due to the interactive nature of the show, no two Blue Man Group performances are ever the same.**

# WHO ARE THE BLUE MEN?

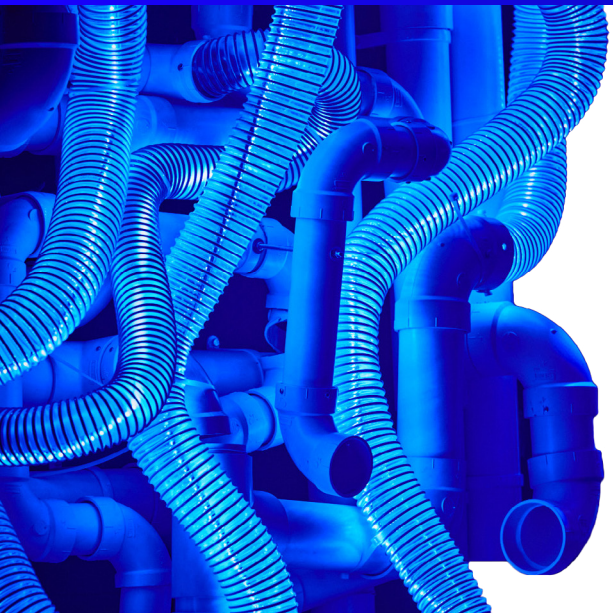
The Blue Men are an “everyman,” exploring and observing our cultural norms.

**The Blue Men don’t speak, but use rhythm, movement, and visual storytelling to communicate with the audience – and with each other.** They aim to connect with the world and the people around them, often in unexpected ways.

The Blue Men draw on and shift between many different classic character archetypes throughout the show. They are curious, investigative, creative, and playful, but also wise. They are interested in exploring our culture and habits, and the audience sees the joys and foibles of humanity reflected in the Blue Men’s discoveries and antics.

## EXPLORATIONS IN SOUND

Music and instruments are at the heart of Blue Man Group, and the Blue Men use a variety of everyday objects to create rhythm and sound.

One of their signature instruments is Drumbone, a trombone-like instrument connected by sliding PVC tubes that is played like a drum.
